Psychology. The concept, subject and tasks of psychology. The system of psychological disciplines. Development of psychic life. Feelings and perceptions. Attention. Learning. Memory and forgetting. Imagination. Motivation. Psychological analysis of activities. Repetition and practice. Habits. Creative activity. Personality psychology (Psychic personality traits. Interests and inclinations. Abilities and giftedness. Temperament. Character.) *Practical part*
